



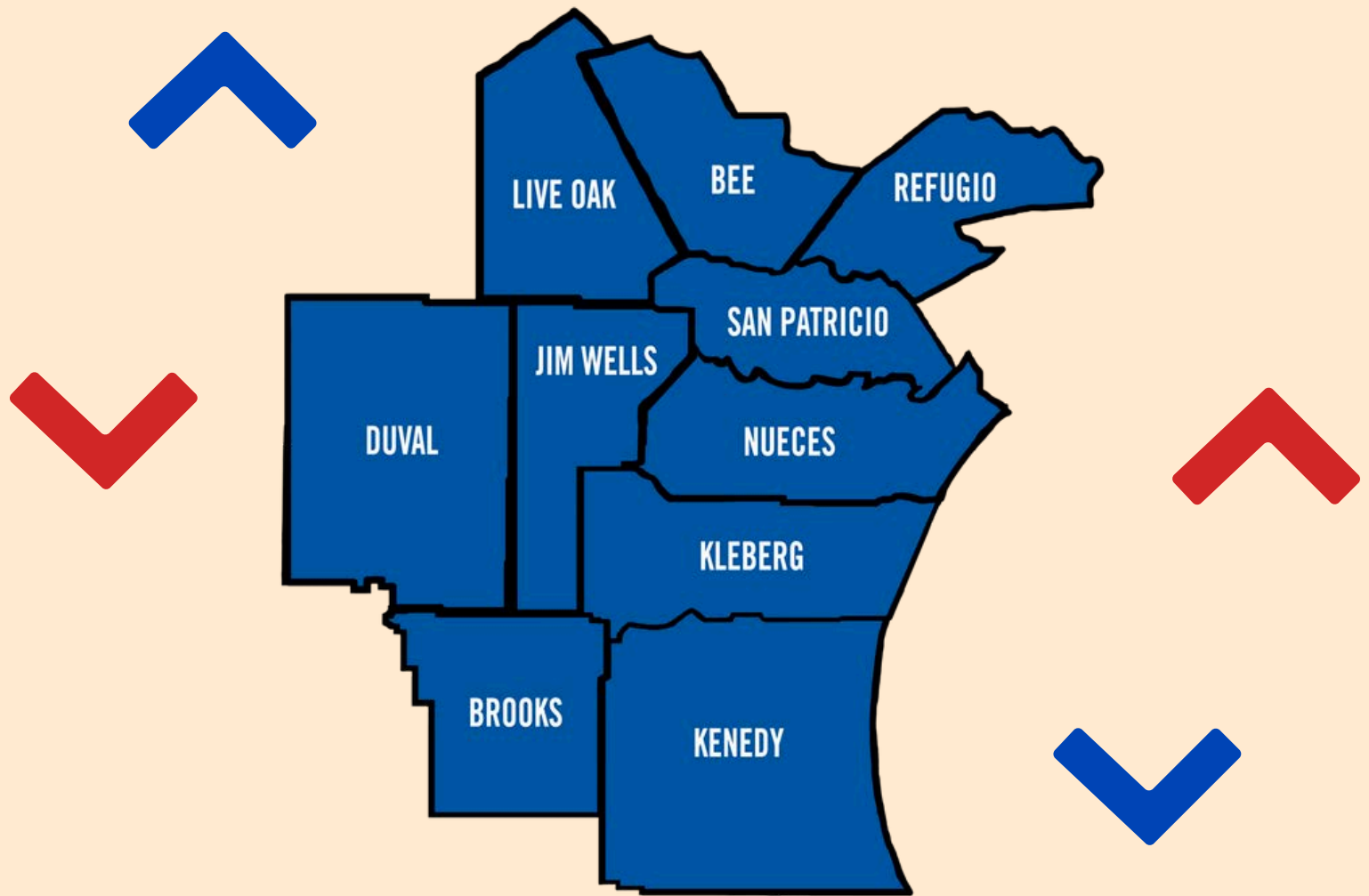

For more than eight decades, United Way of the Coastal Bend has had the support of donors who have helped their neighbors by “mobilizing the caring power of community” as part of our organization’s core mission.

Programs that help children perform well in school, offer job training to those who want to be competitive in a changing workforce, and addressing medical and mental health needs are what shape our society into one that thrives. Together, we changed lives in three areas: health, education, and financial stability.

This annual report covers our fiscal year from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024, and represents just a fraction of the life-changing work we do with our donors, volunteers, and community partners. We are an independent, locally-governed organization serving 10 Coastal Bend counties that’s proud to say: “What’s raised here, stays here!”

UNITED IS THE WAY

We partner with more than 60 agencies across South Texas communities and lead many key programs, including Success by 6 Early Childhood initiative and Operation Supply Our Students, which broke a record this year. Two groups, our Tocqueville Society, which recognizes individuals who contribute at least \$10,000 annually to United Way of the Coastal Bend and Women United, join a national network of philanthropic leaders who are engaged locally to create long-lasting, positive changes.

Charity Navigator, which evaluates hundreds of thousands of charitable organizations in the United States, again awarded UWCB a four-star rating – the highest possible, and we keep at least five years of financial records and audits on our website.

This past year we've had more people want to volunteer their time and put their hearts into making a difference. That's why we look forward to seeing what the future holds. Thank you for joining us in living united.

United Way of the Coastal Bend TOCQUEVILLE SOCIETY



United Way of the Coastal Bend's Tocqueville Society recognizes philanthropic leaders and volunteer champions who have devoted time, talent, and funds to create long-lasting changes by tackling our communities' most serious issues.

Membership in the Society is granted to individuals who contribute at least \$10,000 annually to their local United Way. Founded in Nashville in 1984, the Tocqueville Society is now more than 25,000 members strong worldwide with more than \$9 billion contributed by its members.

Established in 2022, the UWCB Tocqueville Society recorded 15 members in its first year. Current co-chairs are **Erik Simpson**, Vice President and General Manager of Valero Three Rivers Refinery, and **Mitra Khan**, President of Highway Barricades and Services. The Society enjoys small, private gatherings throughout the year to hear from innovative community members in a relaxed environment.

The Society is named for French political philosopher Alexis Charles-Henri de Tocqueville, who traveled to America in 1831 and recorded his observations of the young nation. He applauded and immortalized American voluntary action on behalf of the common good.

South Texans understand that advancing the common good means creating opportunities for all to achieve a better life.

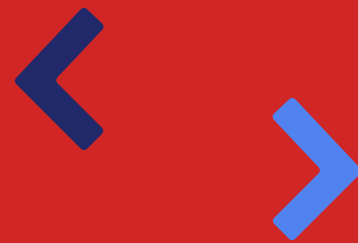

Women United is a self-driven, powerful network of local women dedicated to inspiring and encouraging change in the Coastal Bend.

The group pools the time, talent and financial resources of its members to bring to the forefront the positive impact women can have on a community.

Our projects include:

Improving school readiness through our **SUCCESS BY 6 INITIATIVE**

Our Success By 6 Early Childhood Initiative is a community coalition focused on improving school readiness in children ages 0-5. Working with local agencies, community partners, schools and childcare centers, the initiative provides resources, workshops and events that are child- focused and family-driven to promote the health and development of children in Nueces County. From July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, Success By 6 impacted 2,381 children.



Happy Birthday Baby!

Happy Birthday Baby! is a literacy initiative aimed at strengthening parent-child interactions for bonding and early learning. The initiative provides care bags filled with books, materials and information to families of newborns delivered at local hospitals.

Healthy Mom, Healthy Baby!

Community Resource Fair

To raise prenatal care awareness, Success By 6 hosts a resource fair for expectant mothers and those preparing for pregnancy. Attendees receive care items and information about resources available in the community.

Read Across America Day

Success By 6 brings volunteers into local classrooms to read to children for Read Across America Day. The goal is to instill a love of reading from an early age and remind parents how important it is to read with their children every day.



Read to Lead Preschool Camps

Our Read to Lead Preschool Camps support families by providing school readiness activities. Using small group story time with related activities, preschool children engage in diverse experiences that enhance their literacy, math, and science concepts.

Week of the Young Child

Promoting early literacy development in young children, Success By 6 provides a fun, free public event to highlight community resources and engage families in early learning activities. Activities are low-cost/no-cost so they can be easily replicated at home.

MORE FAMILY RESOURCES

HELP ME GROW COASTAL BEND

The newest Success By 6 Initiative, **Help Me Grow Coastal Bend**, provides families with supportive tools to enhance and monitor their children's learning and development through free developmental screenings and parenting group activities. In addition, families can use Help Me Grow's Findhelp web-based platform to search and access services such as preschool, maternal health, and basic needs.

This collaborative effort strengthens community partnerships and referrals between agencies to ensure families get the help they need when they need it.

United Way of the Coastal Bend is helping fathers get the skills they need to be involved in their children's lives through National Fatherhood Initiative's 24:7 Dad Program.

The free program is the nonprofit's newest effort as part of the Success By 6 Initiative, which works to ensure local children are safe, healthy, and ready for school.

Developed by fathering and parenting experts, 24:7 Dad is the most widely-used evidence-based program designed specifically for fathers.

It focuses on the characteristics that men need to be involved fathers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

This community-based program helps men develop the attitudes, knowledge, and skills they need to get – and stay – involved with their children. 24:7 Dad focuses on key fathering characteristics – like masculinity, discipline, and work/family balance – and helps men evaluate their own parenting skills, as well as their fathering role models.

A group of dads go through a series of free weekly workshops held quarterly that give them the parenting, relationship, and communication skills they need to be involved, responsible, and committed fathers.

Danny "D.J." Jackson, a retired educator with decades of experience, leads the local workshops and quickly gained a dedicated (and enthusiastic) group of fathers.

Supporting families through our **HOME VISITING PROGRAMS**



United Way of the Coastal Bend oversees home visitation efforts for parents of children under five as well as our own in-house Nurse-Family Partnership program for first-time moms.

Home Instruction for Parents of Pre-School Youngsters (HIPPY)

Home Instruction for Parents of Pre-School Youngsters (HIPPY) is an evidence-based program that provides children with a strong foundation to get them ready for school.

Staff works with parents to empower them to become their child's first teacher. The program contains 30 weekly activity packets that cover skills in language, math, science, literacy, and motor skills.

The program provides the curriculum, books, essential school supplies, and all visits are conducted in the family home. The program is free.

From September 2023 through August 2024, the HIPPY program graduated 12 children and served an average of 116 families.

Parents as Teachers (PAT)

Parents as Teachers (PAT) is a free parent education, family support, and school readiness program for families in Nueces and San Patricio counties with children ages 0-5.

From July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, PAT graduated 15 families and served 95 families.

Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP)

Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) is a free community health program that supports first-time moms residing in Nueces county or San Patricio county by having specially-trained nurses regularly visit and provide support early in the pregnancy through the child's second birthday.

From July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, the program graduated 32 clients and served 194 first-time mothers.

Operation Supply Our Students

Raised \$117,710

United Way of the Coastal Bend raised more than \$117,000, including in-kind contributions, and helped more than 30,000 Coastal Bend students in the 2023-2024 school year. The donations provided basic school supplies to the 43 public school districts in United Way of the Coastal Bend's 10-county service area.



Golf Classic

Raised \$196,777

The 30th annual United Way Golf Classic raised more than \$196,000 in 2023 to support United Way of the Coastal Bend's Community Investment Fund. More than 260 golfers participated in the event. 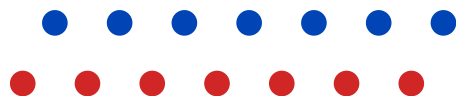

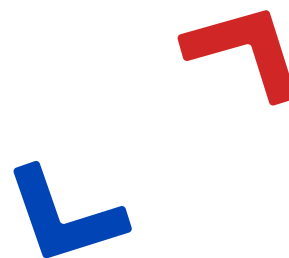
